- Observe and practice safe work methods, rules, and instructions related to our work.
- Report any unsafe work condition, equipment, hazard/risk, accident and incidents to management immediately.
- Participate actively in health and safety at all places of work.
- Wear the relevant personal protective equipment required for our place of work, and make correct use of safety equipment provided.
- Take reasonable care for their own Health and Safety, and do not cause any other person harm due to their omission or action.
